**SHOWER & LAUNDRY FACILITY HOURS:** 24 HR (closed for cleaning after check-out)

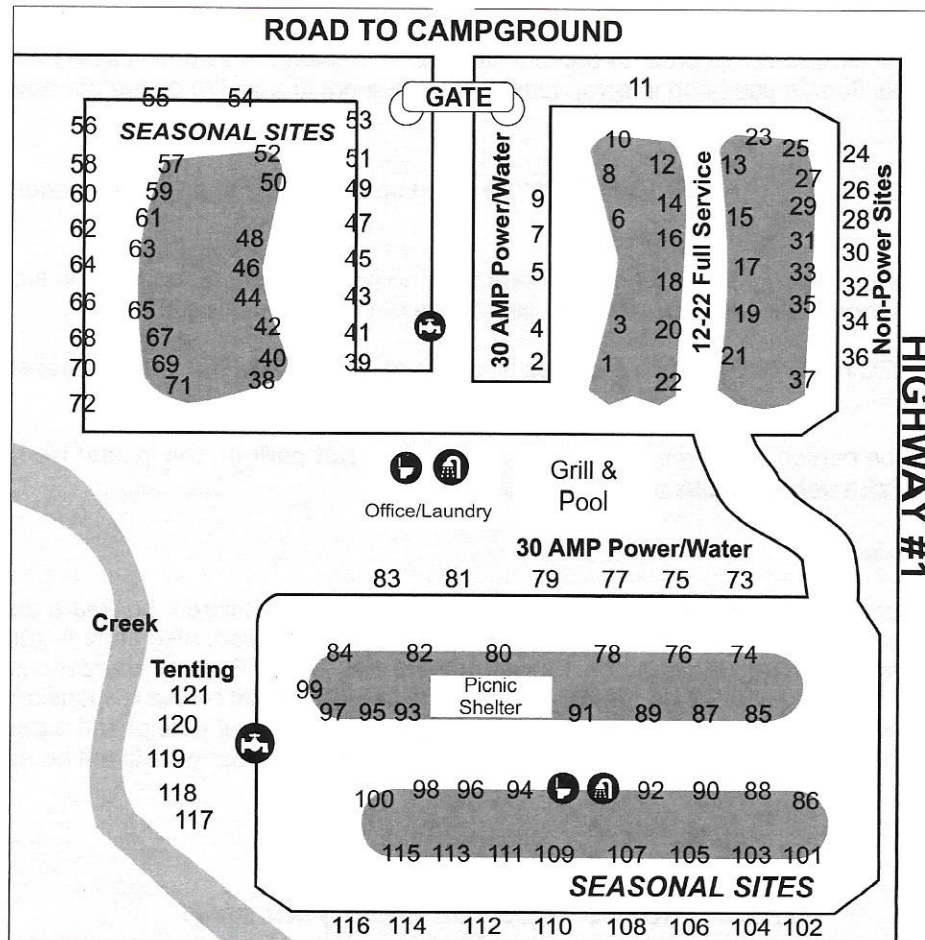

## PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

### FACILITIES

*Escape Grill & Indoor Pool* - located beside the lobby building, free wireless internet hot spot in the restaurant/pool NO PASSWORD, it does not reach to the sites, laundry room & showers.

### PAY PHONES

If you are travelling east, Tourist Information is 2 km or west there is Walsh Gas Station a 15 min. drive. The office phone is only for Emergency use, I'm sorry no exceptions, not even for 800 #'s, collect or calling card.

### CHECK OUT TIME

**11am** for reservation purposes please exit your site prior to check-out time. Late fees apply.

### SITES

One unit per site or one tent (If you choose to have both on one site fees are per unit or per tent, not per site). Please leave your site as you found it for the next guest enjoy. Do not throw your bottle caps, cigarette butts, sunflower seeds on the ground or in the barbeque pits, please dispose of in the trash cans.

### **SPEED LIMIT *For the Safety of Our Children:***

15km/hour at all times

Extended Stay: Must be arranged at check-in. An unscheduled stay-over may require space move and are subject to availability.

Quiet Hours: 11pm - 7am. No Generators. **Fireworks Are Not Permitted.**

### FIRES

In approved fire-pits only, do not leave unattended & extinguish completely before you leave or if it gets windy. **You will be liable for any damages caused by your fire.** No open fires.

### FIREWOOD

Absolutely no outside bark firewood allowed in order to prevent Dutch Elm Disease. Firewood is available to purchase for \$10.00 an armful at the office. Sold until 9pm. If you bring in scrap lumber to burn there is a \$5 fire pit fee per day.

### \*\*\*\*PETS

MUST BE CLEANED UP AFTER, LEASH LAW IN EFFECT\*\*\* Pets tied up outside rig and left unattended will be removed by animal control.

Garbage & Trash: use receptacles in park for household garbage only, no boxes, furniture, appliances etc. **Do not put anything in the barbeque pits except wood**, absolutely **no garbage** as it blows out into the campground.

Pop or beer Cans & Bottles: RECYCLE BIN for cans & bottles is stationed in the lobby. If a bottle is broken, for safety of others please clean it up.

Sites & Parking: each unit will be parked in assigned space only. **Please do not park on the grass; we have water lines that can break when driven on. Extra vehicles can park by the office.**

Park Boundaries: the barbwire fence.

Park Use: all facilities and grounds are used at your own risk. For the safety of your children, be aware that there is a creek, water feature in the valley & fishing pond located on the property that are not supervised. Also there is some wildfire, therefore a lot of holes, be careful when walking around the grounds. Please respect the wildlife. Parents are responsible for the control and behaviour of their children and for any malicious damages. Any damage to facilities will be the responsibility of the guest. We reserve the right to refuse services to anyone. Your registration form acknowledges your receipt and agreements to the policies. Guests who are excessively noisy or who have noisy pets or who otherwise disturb other guests will be asked to vacate the park.
